 A minimum cumulative GPA of 2.00 for all coursework completed at CUC

- · A minimum GPA of 2.00 for all courses taken in the major at CUC
- · A minimum grade of C for all courses taken in a major at CUC
- Payments of all tuition and fees due to Concordia University Chicago.
 All holds must be removed to receive transcripts and diploma.
- The Division of Natural Sciences requires a minimum grade of D-for courses within the major that are not pre-requisites for other courses.
 For courses that are pre-requisites, the C minimum remains unless superseded by admission grade requirements for specific programs, e.g., medicine/dentistry/pharmacy at LECOM, etc.).
