- Minor Cuts
- Nasal Congestion
- Sinus Infections
- Skin Conditions
- Sore Throat
- Staple/Suture Removal

Immunization Requirements

Illinois State Law and CUC policy require all Concordia students who are taking **face to face** classes to provide proof of immunizations through the Med Proctor prior to your first class.

Required immunizations:

- **Measles, mumps, rubella (MMR):** two vaccinations after the first birthday (not required if born before January 1, 1957)
- **Meningitis:** one vaccination after 16th birthday (for students 22 years and younger)
- **Tetanus, Diphtheria and Pertussis (TDAP):** within the past 10 years
- **TB Testing** -Required for international students ONLY within the last 12 months. Must upload chest x-ray if TB Skin test is failed

- **2 primary series Tetanus** for International students ONLY. Toxoid vaccine (TT) is not acceptable.

Please be aware of these requirements and consult with your physician about any additional immunizations that are required.

Students not in compliance with Illinois immunization law 30 days after the first day of classes will have a \$75 non-compliance charge assessed to their student account each semester.
